

# Stoke Row Steam Rally - Privacy Policy

## Looking after your details

Your privacy is important to us and this policy will explain how we use, store and protect any information we have about you. We are committed to ensuring your privacy is protected and should we ask you to provide certain information by which you could be identified, this information will only be used in accordance with the following policy.

## Stoke Row Steam Rally and GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation)

This policy adheres to the new EU law around data protection of 25th May 2018. Although the UK will be subsequently leaving the EU, the UK will continue to adhere to the GDPR following full withdrawal process.

## What is GDPR in summary?

GDPR is the EU's new framework for data protection law and replaces all previous directives. It is designed to harmonise data privacy laws across Europe and applies to all organisations within the EU, it is designed to give greater protection to the individual.

## How this involves you

The Stoke Row Steam Rally does not store any information about you electronically.

We provide entry forms via our website which ask you to send in 2 stamped self-addressed envelopes – one of these we use to send rally entry passes while the other is held back to send an entry form for next years event. This means we do not have to store entrant information electronically to send out entry forms next year.

We also ask you to provide exhibit or entry details to be printed in the rally programme. The programme will list the exhibit details (make, model, registration, year, etc) and the exhibitors name, town and county. We will also list any relevant details you chose to provide about your entry. Note that the programme lists restricted details as it does not contain entrants address or contact information.

## How you can control your personal data held by Stoke Row Steam Rally

You have the right to contact us to ascertain exactly what information we hold on you and you can change your preferences whenever you wish. If you want specific details in the rally programme, then list this in the space provided in the entry form.

## Disclosure of your information

We do not disclose your information to anyone. The restricted details in the programme are publicly available within the programme which is distributed to exhibitors and visitors at the show.

## Storage and retention

We only hold the entry forms and self-addressed envelopes for 1 year to send entry forms for the next years' event.

## **Security**

Security is important to us, rally forms are only held by your section head and those producing the rally programme and are not shared with anyone else.

## **Our website**

If we show links to other websites of interest, then if you use these links and leave our site, it should be noted that we have no control over the security of external websites. We can't be held responsible for the protection of any information you may subsequently provide to them and you should exercise caution before reading their own privacy statement.

We use cookies on our website which collect visitor count information, so that we can see how many people visit the site and how they use it. This helps to improve the performance of the site.
